PLAYING SITES OFFICIALS

Each site will consist of -

Scorekeeper (1 per field)

Official/Umpire (2 per field)

Scorekeeper – Responsible for managing all games played at assigned field; Responsible for reviewing field and facility conditions prior to the start of the first game of the day; Responsible for maintaining timely game schedules; Responsible for maintaining accurate scorebooks, including lineups; Responsible for assuring each field has the required Officials & equipment to start each assigned game; Responsible for maintaining timely game schedules; Responsible for maintaining league supplied game equipment (i.e. balls); Responsible for daily reporting of all final game scores to Director; Responsible for payroll information collection; Responsible for reporting to the Director, the Rainout Line, and scheduled Officials/Umpires, in a timely manner, field conditions in regards to rainouts from/for inclement weather; Responsible for knowing the Louisiana Youth Baseball playing rules.

Officials/Umpires – Responsible for managing and properly officiating all games played at assigned site; Responsible for reviewing field and facility conditions prior to the start of the first game of the day with Scorekeeper & Site Manager; Responsible for maintaining timely game schedules; Responsible for knowing the Louisiana Youth Baseball playing rules, as well as having general baseball knowledge.
